Genesis 12:1-9; 15:1-6; 21:1-7



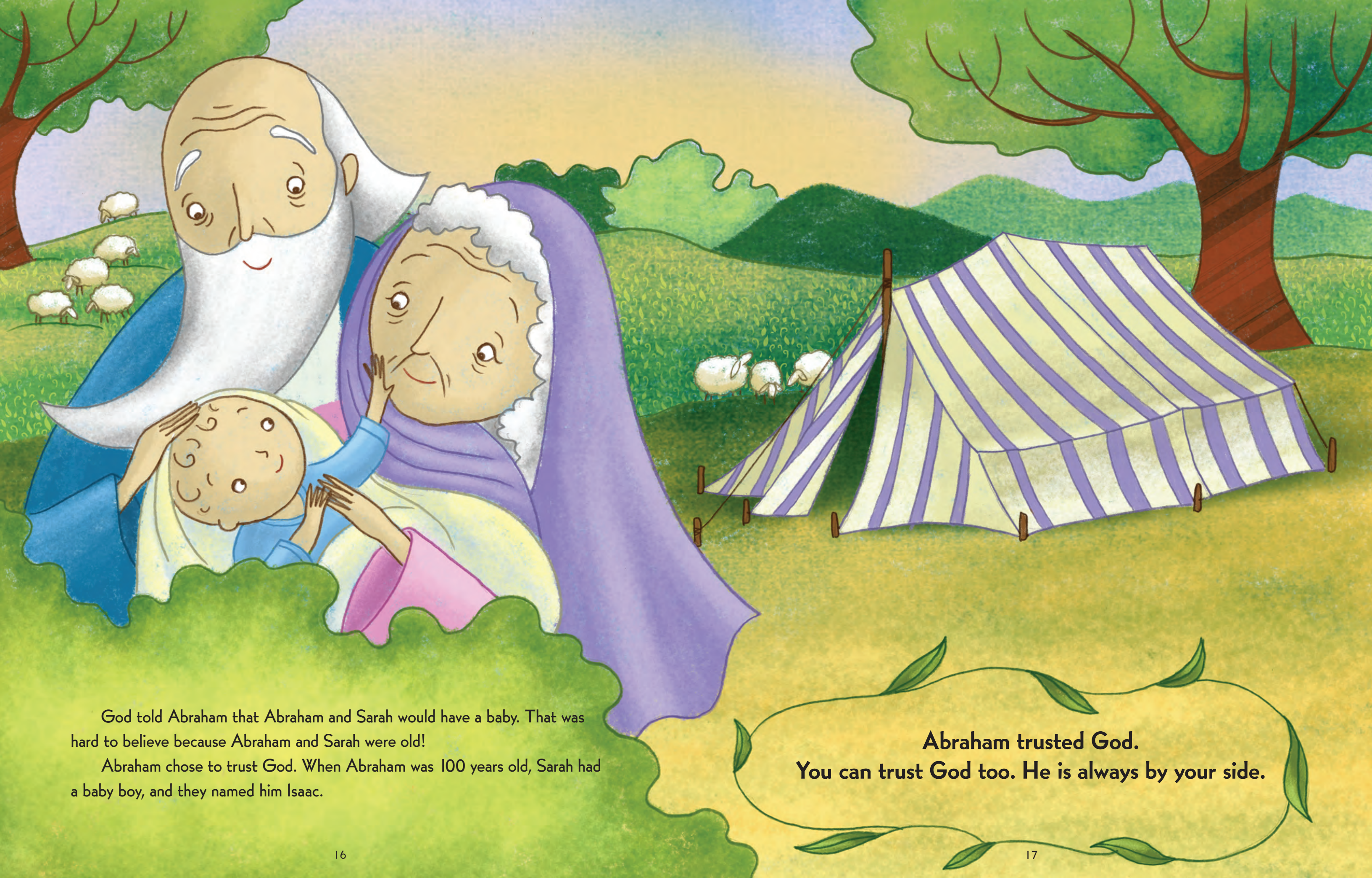
Abraham was a good man who trusted God. God told Abraham, “I want you to leave your home and your country and go to a new land I will show you.”
