


MAP: STATE OF TEXAS / LAND OF THE BIBLE HOUSTON. • ODESSA • EL PASO

Era	Figure	Location	Storyline Summary
Creation	Adam	Eden	Adam is created by God, but he <i>sins</i> and <i>destroys</i> God's original <i>plan</i> for man.
Patriarch	Abraham	Canaan	Abraham is <i>chosen</i> by God to "father" a <i>people</i> to <i>represent</i> God to the world.
Exodus	Moses	Egypt	Through Moses God <i>delivers</i> the Hebrew people from <i>slavery</i> in Egypt and then gives them the <i>Law</i> .
Conquest	Joshua	Canaan	Joshua leads the <i>conquest</i> of the <i>Promised Land</i> .
Judges	Samson	Canaan	Samson and others were chosen as judges to govern the people for four hundred rebellious years.
Kingdom	David	Israel	David, the greatest king in the new <i>monarchy</i> , is followed by a succession of mostly <i>unrighteous</i> kings, and God eventually <i>judges</i> Israel for her sin, sending her into exile.
Exile	Daniel	Babylon	Daniel gives <i>leadership</i> and encourages <i>faithfulness</i> among the <i>exiles</i> for the next seventy years.
Return	Ezra	Jerusalem	Ezra <i>leads</i> the people back from <i>exile</i> to rebuild <i>Jerusalem</i> .
Silence	Pharisees	Jerusalem	Pharisees and others entomb the Israelites in <i>legalism</i> for the next <i>four hundred</i> years.






