

Is *The King is Coming* Bible Study right for your group?



Overview

The King Is Coming is a six-session video Bible study by John Bevere, designed to awaken believers to the reality of Christ's return and empower them to live with purpose, urgency, and hope. Unlike many end-times studies that provoke fear or confusion, this study focuses on preparation and intimacy. Through deep biblical insight and compelling illustrations, John Bevere demystifies prophecy and reveals God's master plan for redemption, moving participants from anxiety about the future to confident expectation of their role in God's eternal kingdom. Participants are challenged to shift their perspective from earthly distractions to eternal realities, helping them build a life of holiness and devotion that eagerly anticipates the King.

Study Structure

This six-week journey is designed to build a solid theological foundation while offering practical application for daily living. Each session uncovers a specific aspect of the end times, moving from the "why" of prophecy to the "how" of living ready.

Typical Session Format (60–90 minutes)

- **Open & Icebreaker**
- **Video Teaching** (approx. 20 - 30 mins)
- **Group Discussion** (approx. 30-40 mins)
- **Respond** - a short, personal exercise to help reinforce the key ideas.
- **Pray** - short prayer prompts to help the group take the next step together.

Key Features

Sessions

- **Week 1: Why Don't We Talk About It?** – Confronts the silence and misconceptions surrounding the second coming, establishing why prophecy is a blessing, not something to be afraid of.
- **Week 2: The Divine Master Plan** – Explores God's eternal purpose designed before creation, helping believers see where they fit into the bigger picture.
- **Week 3: The Ancient Jewish Wedding** – A transformative look at the biblical metaphor of the Bridegroom and the Bride, revealing the depth of Christ's love and commitment.
- **Week 4: Is It the Season of Jesus' Return?** – Examines biblical signs of the times, like the fig tree analogy, to help participants recognize the season without setting dates.
- **Week 5: The Catching Away of His Bride** - Clarifies the "Harpazo" (catching away) and the hope believers have in being united with Christ.
- **Week 6: How Shall We Live?** - A practical culmination of the study, focusing on how an eternal perspective changes our priorities, evangelism, and pursuit of holiness today.

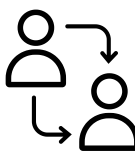
