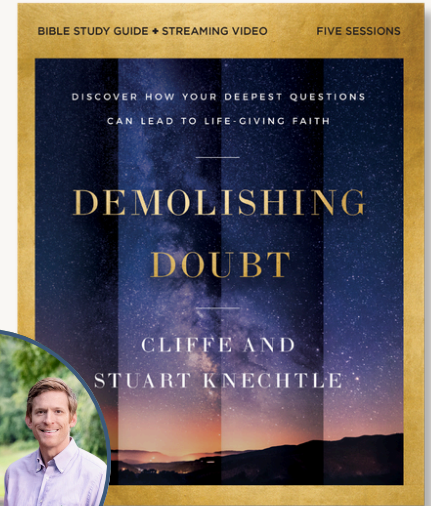


# IS *DEMOLISHING DOUBT* RIGHT FOR YOUR GROUP?

## Overview

In a culture that often views faith with skepticism, it is natural to wrestle with hard questions and even doubts about God. *Does he actually exist? Is the Bible historically accurate? Is there credible evidence that Jesus was the Son of God and rose from the dead?*

You aren't alone in wanting to feel confident in your convictions. Just like every Christian throughout history, you want to know that your faith rests on a solid foundation of truth. This Bible study is designed to walk alongside you and provide this reassurance.



## Study Structure

Through five sessions, Cliffe and Stuart Knechtle, founders of the *Give Me an Answer* ministry and YouTube channel, discuss the toughest topics facing believers today. Each session includes a video conversation, group discussion time and five days of personal study and application.

### Typical Session Format (90-120 minutes)

- Connect (10-20 minutes)
- Watch the Video (25 Minutes)
- Group Discussion (35-50 minutes)
- Personal Response (10-15 minutes)
- Closing Prayer (10-15 minutes)

## Sessions

1. **What Is the Evidence for God?** Take a look at the evidence for God through the cosmological, teleological, moral, and problem-of-evil arguments, supported by Scripture, science, and personal reflection.
2. **Are the Gospels Historically Reliable?** Explore compelling evidence that the Gospels are historically reliable and trustworthy accounts of Jesus' life, death, and resurrection.
3. **Is The Evidence About Jesus Trustworthy?** Examine historical reliability, Jesus' explicit claims to divinity, supporting evidence through miracles and fulfilled prophecy, and the message of salvation by grace.
4. **Did Jesus Really Rise From the Dead?** Investigate the historical evidence for Jesus' resurrection and see how the resurrection anchors Christian faith with hope, purpose, and the promise of eternal life.
5. **Why Is Faith So Important?** Faith matters as a reasoned trust in Jesus grounded in evidence, expressed through obedience and perseverance in doubt and suffering, and strengthened by remembering God's past faithfulness.

## Key Features

- 1 Expert Conversations:** Each week features a video conversation between Cliffe, Stuart, and a college student. Watch as they discuss the toughest topics facing believers today.
- 2 Discussion-Oriented:** Significant time is dedicated to group discussion, allowing participants the opportunity to work through the topics from the video. The Leader's Guide (found at the back of the Study Guide) provides tips for facilitating these conversations.
- 3 Personal Study:** Between meetings, engage with five days of personal study. Strengthen your faith and gain tools to engage your friends, family, and community in meaningful dialogue.
- 4 Five-Week Schedule:** The five-week format is easy to adapt for individual study, small groups, or church-wide discipleship programs.
