
## Angel Visits Mary and Jesus is Born

## The Road to Damascus

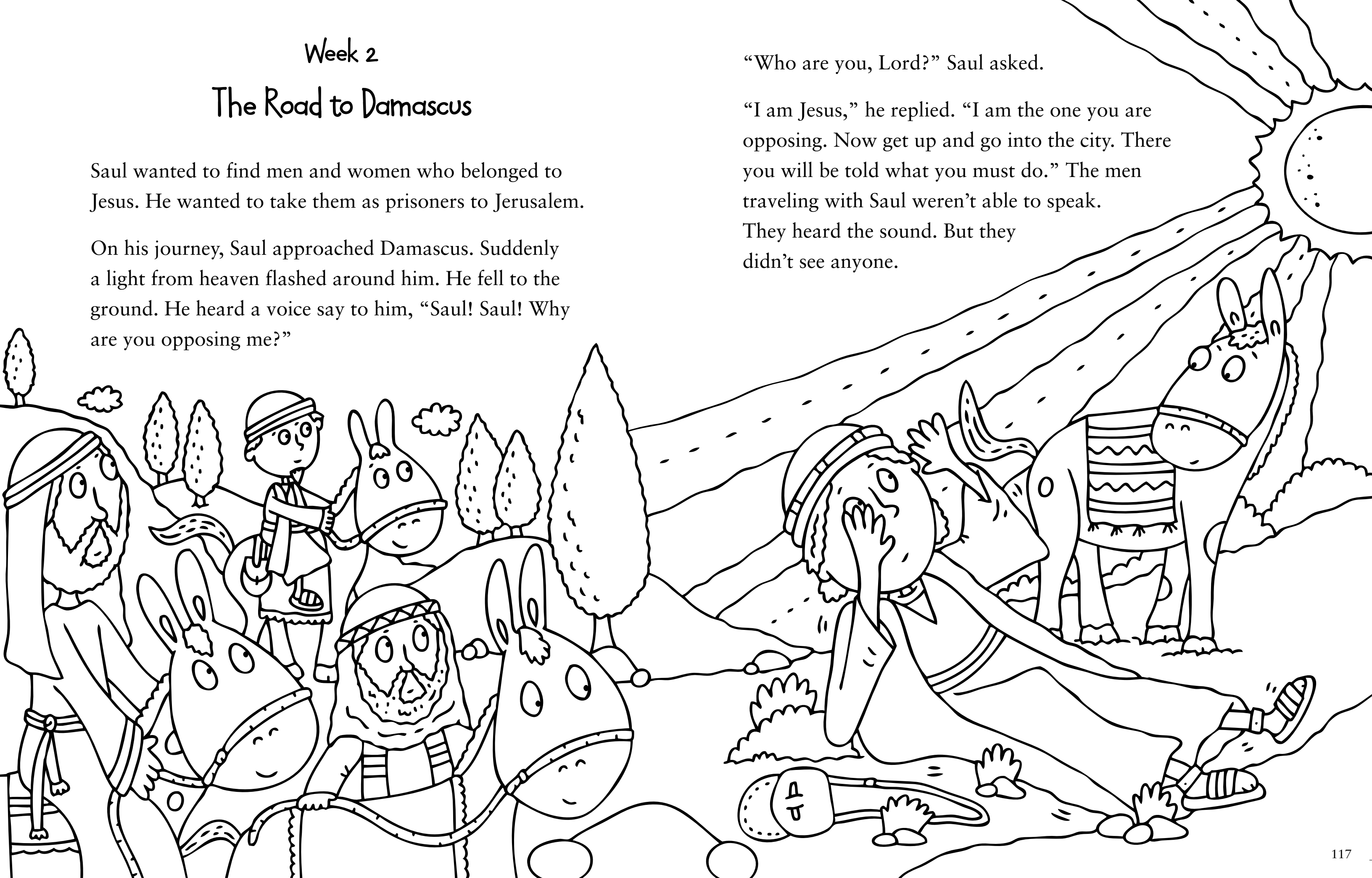
Saul wanted to find men and women who belonged to Jesus. He wanted to take them as prisoners to Jerusalem.
